Free on-line storage and file synchronization

What Does Dropbox Do?

It keeps a copy of your files on line and on your computer(s)

- the same copies of each file
- you can sync with multiple computers, i.e. home and work
- you can work on things on your iPhone or Blackberry too!

It provides automatic back up of important files

 also it provides version control: you can check back for previous versions of files that you changed (either purposely or inadvertantly).

You can share files in specific folders with friends

- each person can edit files, but only in shared folder
 - they can't see your other stuff
- files get synced across all users and their computers

You can store some files in a public folder

- share pictures, audio/video files with everyone
- e.g. host a picture you then post to a web forum

Are There Limitations?

- The free version provides only 2 GB (which is a lot)
- You can get a paid version
 - 50 GB for \$10/mo
 - 100 GB for \$20/mo
- If you sign up, using the referral link I'm providing, I get an extra ½ GB

How Do I Get/Use It?

Sign up for an account

use referral link, http://ping.fm/bkcbx, and I get some extra space (wh00t!)

Download the app and install on your computer

- works for windows and Mac
- also a mobile phone app (sync everywhere!)

Once installed, Dropbox acts like a folder on your computer.

- do your work in Dropbox on one computer
- then take it up on another...or your phone
- I use it to send things to my wife's computer (she has a printer, I don't)
- when I had a real job, I used it to work on things at home or at work without having to worry about forgetting to email files to back and forth, losing my usb stick, having a corrupt floppy disk, etc.
